All band members are required to purchase certain personal items for public performances. Unless indicated as “optional” or you already own the items, you must purchase them. Items are available for purchase on our online store. Visit www.penncrestband.org to access the store. Although payments will be securely made through PayPal, you do NOT need a PayPal account to make a purchase. You may purchase items using your credit card.

Your purchase represents your student’s ONE YEAR COMMITMENT to the program and is due Friday, JUNE 21st. Once we receive your order, we will create a spot for your student in the field show that cannot be removed and cannot be filled by anyone else. **If your student leaves the program, no refunds can be issued.**

The following groups must order the following items:

PERCUSSION: Red shirt, Marching shoes, Jock Jams, Tuxedo shirt for use during concert band

FRONT ENSEMBLE AND ALL OTHER INSTRUMENTALISTS: Red shirt, Marching shoes, Jock Jams, Black band gloves, Tuxedo shirt for use during concert band

COLOR GUARD: Red shirt, Guard shoes, and if your child is also enrolled in concert band, he/she will need a Tuxedo shirt

All wind players are expected to provide their own lyre and flip folder. They are available at most music stores. If you use a school instrument, we can supply a lyre for you.

All clothing/equipment will be issued during uniform fitting days (TBD) or during Band Camp.
